## Entries

## Starts

Each school will have an allocated start block. Start lists will be published as soon as possible after closing date.

Start times will be from 10:00am for am race. And 2pm for pm race. The pm race will have a chasing start for the top 10 places from the am race reverse order fastest starts last. There will be at least 1 minute gap between runners on the same course.

## Timekeeping

Timing will be done using the Sport Ident electronic punching system. Students may use their own sport Ident stick. An ident stick may be borrowed for the day if the student doesn't own one. If providing their own ident the number must be given on the entry form. Loan idents must be collected from registration by each school co-ordinator on arrival.

## Terrain

The terrain is the usual school environment including sports fields and an environmental area at Pukekohe High. Strathallan has multi levels with upper level marked on the map as a separate insert.

## Directions

For **Pukekohe High** parking will be in John Street which is the west side of the school. As you enter the John Street gate there will be an assembly area on the grass which will be available for school tents.

For **Strathallan** AGC park in the main park as you approach the school. Assembly area is on the field as you enter the school. Please observe the out of bounds areas i.e. the school buildings.
